"I realize I'm sitting where my Dad danced with my friends to the records I received for my 10th birthday, and I smile. This is rudely interrupted by the vision of his hospice bed where he took his last breath four months prior, and then the thousands of memories flooding me became overwhelming. I could not stop the tears. "Grief stinks!" I thought, and it extra-stunk that everything seemed to change in a moment. I longed to hear his laughter and beautiful tenor singing along to the music of the holidays, but I knew I never would again."

This quote from a friend, the first Christmas after her father passed, carries a common theme about the emotional impact and random onset of grief. We grieve the people, situations, and things that are now absent but had a significant impact on our lives in a long-lasting way. We experience loss through death, job transitions, moving, pandemics, changes in health and wealth, as well as successfully launching children into adulthood. Life is forever changing, and we can't ignore it.

Here is some guidance on how to move through your grief this holiday season:

- Talk about the situation or person you are missing.
- Practice self-compassion and allow yourself time to not be overly happy or cheery.
- · Allow yourself time to cry.
- Allow yourself time to laugh and enjoy the new moments.
- Allow space for everyone to grieve in their own way and timeframe.
- Avoid numbing your feelings with alcohol or substances as this often causes more long-lasting problems.
- Speak openly about what you need to get through the holidays.
- · Let others extend care, support, and help to you.
- \bullet Explore what old traditions you want to keep/change and new ones that you want to add.

If you feel overwhelmed by grief and it has been longer than two months since your loss, I encourage you to connect with a professional counselor who can support you through the feelings of confusion, loneliness, sadness, and anxiety. The feelings of grief don't have to last forever.

It was the young couple's first out-ofcountry vacation. Mike and Doreen were walking along the beaches of Punta Cana in the Dominican Republic as the sun began to set over the turquoise waters. Up ahead, Doreen spotted tiki torches lighting a beautifully set private dinner table surrounded by vibrant flowers. Doreen pointed it out to Mike, saying, "That is the sweetest thing I've ever seen", which is when Mike took her hand and led her to a night they'd never forget- A night that began the rest of their lives.

Both hailing from the East Coast, Mike and Doreen's lives have always seemed to share the same trajectory. Mike was very close with his family who always emphasized the importance of being together, the outdoors, and spent their summers on the beaches of Jersey. Doreen, an only child, also came from a tight-knit household where family was everything. For her, cousins were siblings, and summers were spent tromping the beaches in Ocean City, Maryland.

Always striving for more, Mike and Doreen found passion from an early age. For Mike, it was athletics. He loved all sports but excelled in football

and baseball. For Doreen, it was entrepreneurialism. By 6, she'd created an in-home store which all her relatives had to pass through and to make their purchases after Sunday mass. After graduating high school, both

attended Saint Joseph's University in Philadelphia where Mike earned his degree in finance and Doreen earned hers in healthcare, as well as a Masters in Counseling Psychology. While in college, Doreen knew Mike's friends and Mike knew Doreen's, and while they consistently crossed paths, the two simply failed to connect. It wasn't until after graduating, with Doreen living in Arizona and occasionally traveling home to visit family and friends (friends who happened to be roommates with Mike), that they actually had their first real conversation and realized their similarities vastly outweighed their differences. Once that connection was made, there was no going back, and after dating long distance for a brief period, Doreen moved back to be with him.

Prior to their trip to Punta Cana, Mike had asked Doreen's parents for their blessing and, with their approval,

he slipped the ring through customs. After sharing that firelit, private dinner beside the ocean, the two danced on the sand and Mike took a knee.

They were married in 2009, and always aspiring to have a big family of their own (Doreen's magic number being 4 kids), they soon introduced their first, Michael, to the world in 2011. When Michael was 9 months old, Doreen was ready for their second, but try as they might pregnancy wouldn't take. After going through two rounds of IVF, however, it finally did and the Korba's were overjoyed.

Tragically, at 39 weeks their unborn daughter, Harper, suffered complications with her umbilical cord and passed. The event was life-altering for Doreen and Mike, and through the pain of their loss, they underwent a complete perspective shift. They realized more than ever the importance of family, and Doreen subsequently left her position in corporate America to go into business for herself to allow more time at home. In Harper's honor, they started a non-profit donating bereavement package to hospitals for patients experiencing similar, unexpected and heartbreaking losses.

MEET THE KORBA FAMILY

"You have to make something good come out of it," Doreen said in an interview. "It's the only way, otherwise it could swallow you whole."

Life, however, works in mysterious ways. After being unable for so long, Doreen became pregnant in 2016 with their daughter, Josie, and a little over a year after Josie's arrival came Quinn. And though Harper may not be here physically, her spirit has always lived among the Korba's, and in essence, Doreen had the 4 children she'd always imagined.

In 2018, the family relocated to the Pacific Northwest following a work opportunity for Mike who has been a proud and important part of 3M, a massive and historic company, for the past 17 years. And after landing in Camas, as the Korba's will attest, life couldn't be better.

"We love this community and we're thankful every day," says Doreen, "The focus on family, the kindness. It's like a Hallmark town! It preserves childhood, and that's something Mike and I always wanted for our kids."

Michael, now 11, is a 6th grader at Skyridge and loves sports nearly as much as his father who's been coaching him along the way in all things athletics. For Mike, it's about having that quality time with his son, time he wouldn't trade for the world. Josie, who's about the enter 1st, is as entrepreneurial as her mother, and needing something to do while attending her brother's sporting events began making team bracelets. Well, her concept quickly caught on, and now she boasts her own stand inside Papermaker Pride downtown. Quinn, who's in preschool, rules the roost and loves her friends just as much as she loves to dance, and Doreen is proud to say that she'll never have to worry about Quinn standing her ground. Doreen has continued her

work empowering women and mothers who've experienced heartbreak the way she has. She hosts a podcast and does coaching work to spread as much love and light as she can to those who need it most. And Harper, who continually shines on them from above, is always sending her love in the form of hearts- whether it be Josie's heart-shaped birthmark or the dozens of hearts stones they've collected while exploring Lacamas Lake.

The Korba's share a bond that goes beyond words. They live for one another and cherish their shared moments. What they've always known, and has been continuously solidified throughout the years, is that nothing is more important than family, and they're grateful to have found a community that feels the same.

Rescue, Adopt, Support!

he spacious lobby of the Humane Society for Southwest Washington (HSSW) is deceiving. The rest of the building is crammed with busy offices, storage areas filled with kibble and kitty litter, medical facilities, and of course, rows of kennels filled with hopeful faces awaiting adoption.

Founded in 1897, the mission of the organization is to "rescue, return, restore, rehome, reconnect, one animal at a time," and last year they served almost 6,500 animals. Pets are not only received from animal control. Some are surrendered, and others are transported from overwhelmed communities beyond Vancouver.

While cats and dogs make up most of the residents, space is sometimes needed for other animals such as rabbits, guinea pigs, mice, goats, and roosters.

Last year, the shelter completed an impressive 4,002 adoptions. However, Marketing and Outreach Manager Sam Ellingson explained, they now want to focus on expanding animal care out into the community, instead of just within their walls.

"We've noticed fewer families are looking to adopt a pet and more families looking for support services to help them care for their existing pets," said Sam. By expanding their





Community Solutions program, HSSW is helping to keep pets and families together.

This program supports local families in a variety of ways and includes providing medical care for an accidental injury pet food assistance (40,000 pounds distributed last year)

limited time emergency boarding - such as during wildfire evacuations, house fires, or families fleeing domestic violence cat surgeries through the "Spay and Save" program

"Last year we completed over 15,000 medical exams at our facility, and at Wellness Clinics we attend in partnership with groups like Open House Ministries, where we provide resources for the pets of folks experiencing homelessness."

HSSW plans to expand the number of Wellness Clinics it provides annually to include offering pet food assistance, and basic medical exams, for pet owners living in shelters and transitional housing.



amas native, Grant Bergstrom, began laying the foundation for his long career in the dietary supplement industry as his father's first full-time employee at Bergstrom Nutrition, formerly Cardinal Associates, founded in 1988. After accruing years of firsthand knowledge and experience, Grant ventured out to broaden his horizons, traversing the globe, until opportunity ultimately brought him home.

After graduating from Camas High in 1990 and attending the University of Washington, Grant returned to help his father grow Cardinal/Bergstrom to become the world's leading manufacturer of the MSM ingredient which they sold to the industry's biggest brand names. Desiring to venture out into global commercialization roles for companies like The Wright Group and Unigen, Grant fortified connections and broadened his understanding while simultaneously looking for a consumer product brand he could start, earn his way into, or possibly buy.

Primarily sold and distributed through the Healthcare Practitioner (HCP) channel, the brilliance of Dr. Massey was his manufacturing of combination products which he coined "condition specific". These products provided greater nutritional benefits in less volume which led to a higher likelihood of compliance, a major win for all parties considered.

Prior to leaving Cardinal/Bergstrom, Grant was actually involved with an investor group that had considered purchasing Mountain Peak at the time, though things didn't pan out. Then, in 2019, a mutual friend brought the Masseys and Bergstroms together at the perfect confluence of when the Masseys were ready to sell and the Bergstroms were ready to buy, and for Grant, it was a full circle moment.

The acquisition also brought Grant and Maureen back to Grant's roots. Initially

located in Beaverton, the couple initially had to commute from SW Washington to Mountain Peak, which proved especially challenging for Maureen, who still allocated half her schedule to nursing part-time at the Vancouver Clinic. In 2022, however, Maureen officially switched to Mountain Peak fulltime, and in another full circle event, they relocated the company to the Columbia Tech Center, just a stone's throw from where his father built Bergstrom.

Today, Mountain Peak continues to supply supplements made of the best nutrients on the market. Currently, they offer over 30 conditionspecific products that cover over 90% of what an HCP would commonly see in their clinics, everything from gastrointestinal support to sleep aid. Though still distributed mainly through the HCP channel, they recently began supplying directly to consumers with products now available on Amazon or directly through their website.

Under Grant and Maureen's guidance, Mountain Peak continues to grow, not just because of the value of the products they offer, but because of the way Grant and Maureen complement one another. They're a team that truly aims for the mountain's peak, and together a dream has already been realized, a family business has been brought home, and life has truly come full circle.
